Missing Time Notification

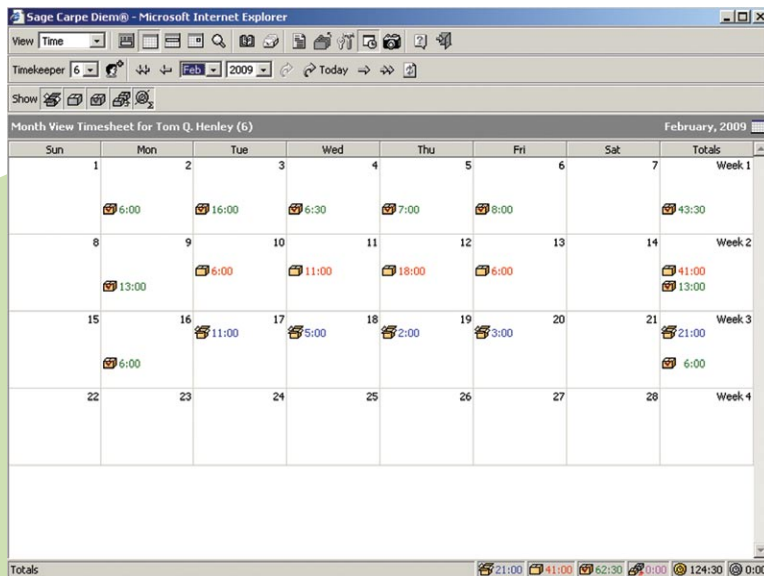
Track the minimum required hours for each timekeeper and then send reminder e-mails if minimum time is not entered within the period. Additional e-mails can be sent to a Manager or the Administrator.

Multiple Calendar, Time Zone and Regional Settings

CDWeb provides customized settings for entering time from anywhere in the world, so information is accessed quickly and easily for reporting and billing purposes. With multiple calendar support, you can define multiple calendars, each with its own list of holidays, first day of the work week, and fiscal year-end settings. This allows you to use Sage Carpe Diem to collect time and expense entries for timekeepers working in different locations and multiple business units that observe different calendar constants. CDWeb also supports multiple time zones, as well as regions, allowing you to set the month names, days, and currency format of the selected regions.

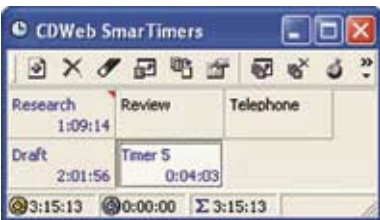

And the thin architecture of CDWeb allows instant online access without occupying valuable space on each timekeeper's hard drive. All upgrades and system administration functions are accessed online, saving time for IT maintenance and support.

- Like Sage Carpe Diem, CDWeb offers an integrated Glossary, enabling your team to work faster by creating personal abbreviations for commonly used terms and phrases. When entering narrative text, the timekeeper simply types the glossary abbreviation and CDWeb automatically expands the abbreviation to its full phrase.
- The Report Assistant allows staff to print time or expense entries in a range of reporting formats. Easily generate custom reports using a variety of report templates. The reports can be saved as PDFs and automatically displayed in the browser, similar to the Sage Carpe Diem desktop version.
- CDWeb remembers recently used clients, projects and other validation information in "favorites". This provides an easy way for timekeepers to choose validation values, rather than wade through a long list of validation choices.
- The enhanced date entry form saves time for administrative personnel, providing quick-step features in the data entry process.
- Temporary IDs are a snap to obtain, which is important for new clients or projects that are not yet entered into the system. Timekeepers can create entries or SmarTimer data using temporary values for clients or projects. When clients/projects become available in the billing system, timekeepers can instantly update all entries that use the same temporary values.
- CDWeb allows you to create time and expense sheet templates from the Day View, Week View, and Search Results View, which can save you time in re-entering duplicate data.
- CDWeb allows the system manager to integrate Sage Carpe Diem and Windows domain authentication. In addition to allowing the system manager to select a security mode, the Security Mode dialog box provides the options needed to configure integrated domain authentication providing more flexible security options.
